



PROCEDURES FOR PRESENTING DRAFT RESOLUTIONS FOR ACCEPTANCE BY THE CIVIL SOCIETY FORUM, 4-5 October, Chisinau

Dear Participants,

This is to remind you that every Forum participant who has a right to vote can present draft resolutions in Chisinau. Two people are needed as proposers of resolutions but the number of people who can sign a draft resolution is unlimited. Resolutions can also be presented en bloc by National Platforms and Working Groups or coalitions there of as long as a presenter of the draft and a seconder are clearly identified.

Draft resolutions can be presented AT ANY TIME **between NOW and 19.00 on October 4**th. Draft resolutions will be accepted after this deadline but only in exceptional circumstances. The language of the draft can be English or Russian or both. The resolutions committee would ask you to send drafts electronically to <u>steeringcommittee@eap-csf.eu</u> with contact details including a mobile phone number.

The Resolutions Commission which consists of Krzysztof Bobinski, (co-chair of the CSF Steering Committee) with Oleksandr Sushko (Ukraine national coordinator) and Yaryna Borenko (WG4 co-coordinator) will be responsible for the procedures connected with tabling and adoption of resolutions by the Forum. The Commission encourages you to send in drafts as early as possible as this will make its work easier. It goes without saying that the Commission will welcome clear and concise texts but there is no formal limit on the length of the texts. The commission will do its utmost to provide hard copies of draft texts before the session at which they will be accepted. The commission reserves the right to edit texts where the language is unclear and to talk to proposers of texts which are similar to encourage them to merge them.

The resolutions will be voted at the session beginning at **15.30 on October 5th**. Obviously the assembly has the right to propose amendments from the floor and new resolutions can also be accepted for voting at the session.
