



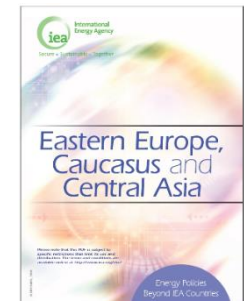

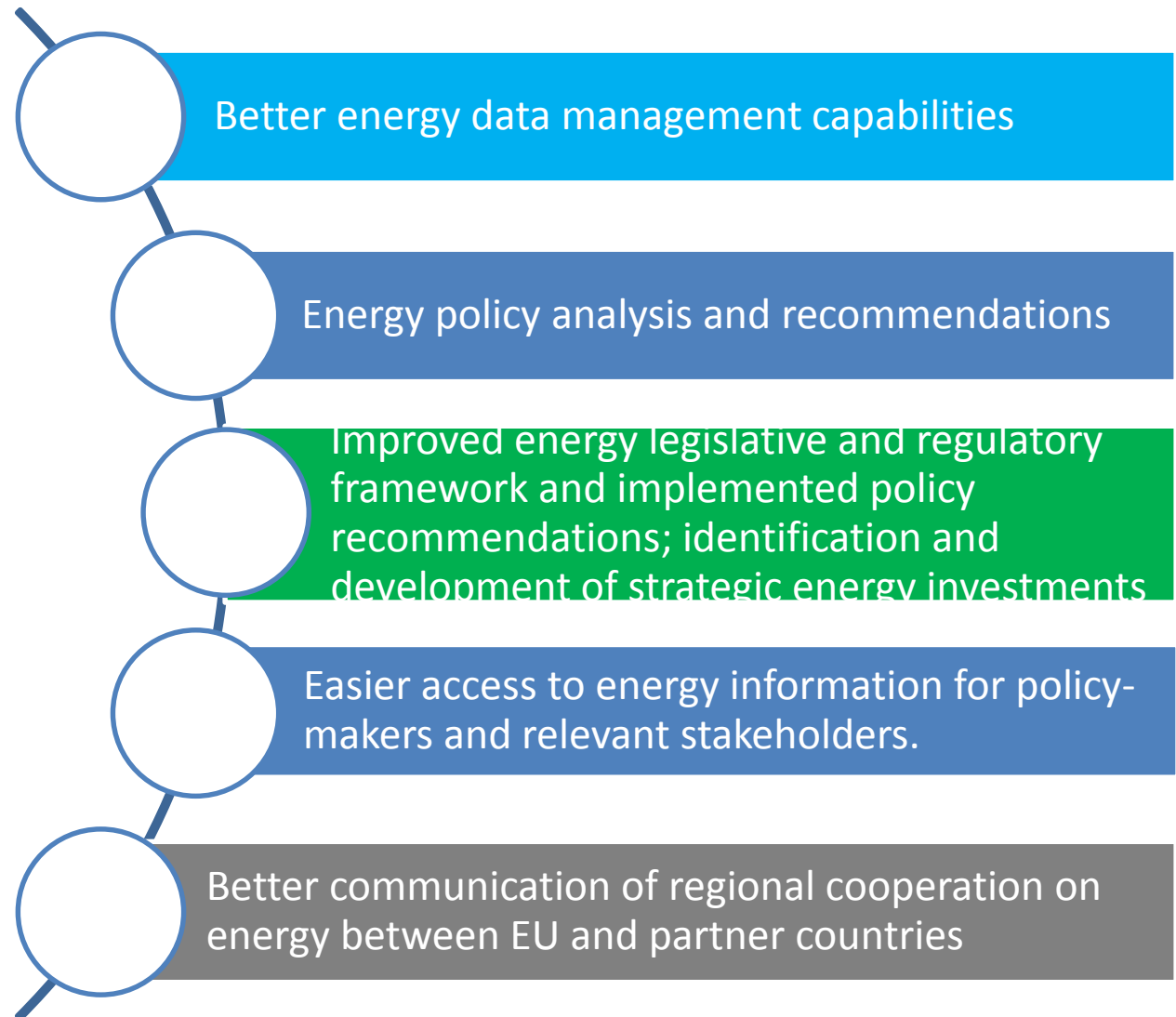
Objective:

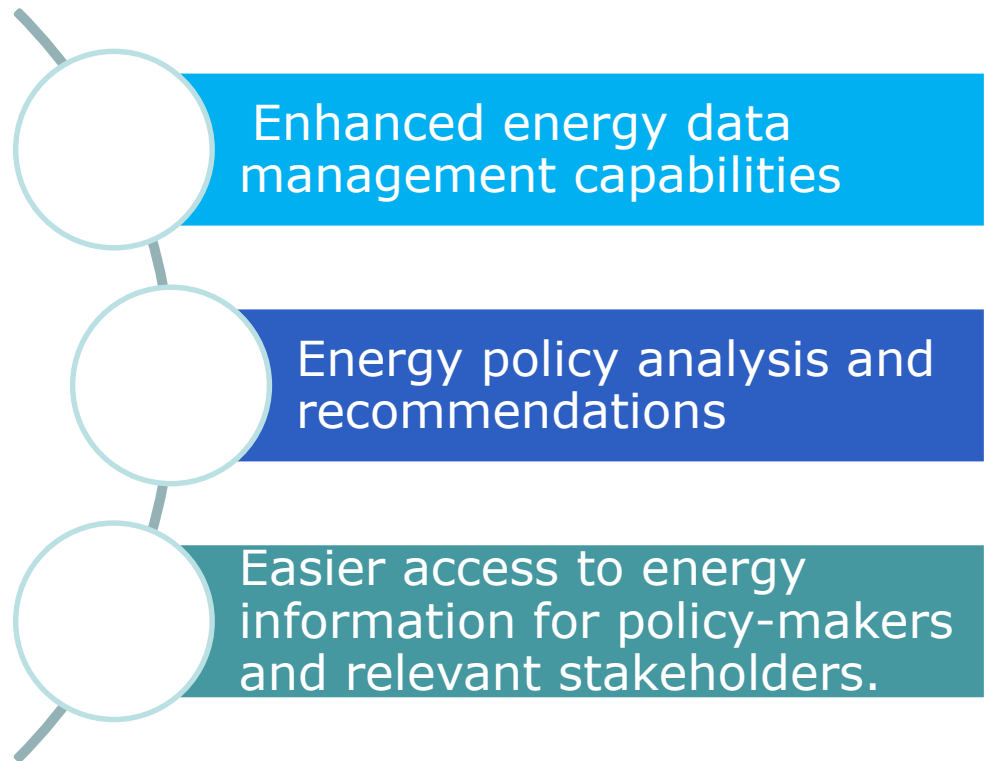
