ICE BREAKER RECEPTION

There is a welcome reception in City Hall on November 28th, at 6 PM. Buses will leave at 5.30 PM from Clarion Hotel Stockholm Skanstull and head back to the hotel from the reception at 8 PM. Those of you that are self-organized can join the bus or go by public transport, bus nr 3 or metro stop *Rådhuset* on the Blue Line. Please make sure you are at the City Hall on time.

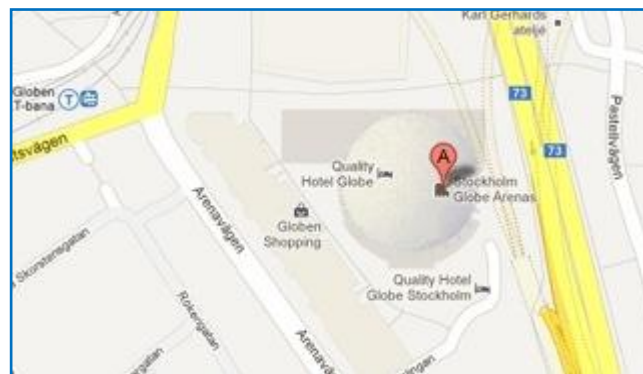

HOW TO GET THERE

Transportation by bus to and from the conference venue from the Clarion Hotel Stockholm Skanstull is provided.



For those participants that come by public transport, the conference venue is very close to the metro stop “Globen” on the so-called *Green line* towards “Hagsätra”. Once you get out of the metro cross the walk bridge towards the shopping centre and large spherical building called “Globen”. Take a right follow the signs *Skyview* walking between the shopping centre and the Globe. Once you have passed the Skyview attraction keep on walking for app. 100 meter, go down the stairs at the end of the passage and the venue is on your left hand

PUBLIC TRANSPORT

Public transport is generally very well organized, timely and safe in Stockholm. However like in all capitals please take care of your personal belongings as pick pockets can be active especially around central station.

The easiest way to get around is by Metro. No matter where you go in the larger Stockholm area the costs are always the same (appr.46 Kronor) so you can always by the same ticket. Most stations have ticket machines where you can



buy a ticket with your credit card. However please note if you buy a ticket from the person in the booth you cannot pay by credit card.

TAXI

There are many taxi companies to choose from in Stockholm. Approved taxis with metered fares always bear yellow number plates. Credit cards are readily accepted. Please be advised that taxis in Stockholm are quite expensive.

PAYMENT

Please note that Sweden does **not** have the Euro but that the currency in Sweden is the Swedish krona. 10 EURO is approximately 86 SEK. Credit cards are widely accepted.

At restaurants, a 5-10 per cent tip is usually added to the dinner tab if you are happy with the service.
